The Web of Ed is a free, interactive tool that helps students explore what they're interested in and what might come after high school — turning that exploration into something concrete they can act on.

WHAT STUDENTS GET OUT OF IT

- **An interest quiz that starts the conversation**
A short quiz gives every student a personalized starting point, matched to real fields of study and careers worth exploring.
- **Real career data, not just job titles**
664+ career profiles include typical pay, day-to-day duties, and the exact education or training path required — so students see what a path actually involves.
- **Something to actually show for it**
Students leave with a fillable speech script connecting their quiz results to a field and career they explored — ready to share with a teacher, counselor, or family.
- **No accounts, no data collected**
Everything runs entirely in the student's own browser — nothing to sign up for, nothing stored.

The Web of Ed was built by a Colorado special education teacher and coach who kept hearing the same question from students: “What can I even do with this?” It’s meant to work the way knowledge actually connects — not a ranked list, but a web, where every path leads somewhere real and no student is told they took a wrong turn.
